

Covid-19

Diamond Bay Bowling Club is operating according to a Covid-Safe Plan, as required by the NSW Government.

Because of social distancing requirements, our main hall is currently limited to 64 patrons.

For individuals and groups wanting to lawn bowl, we are happy to accommodate you. We have a number of precautions in place, and we believe that we can make your bowling experience as safe and enjoyable as possible.

As per the government's health requirements, we have a "conditions of entry" requirement:

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All patrons are required to sign in when entering the Club – printing name, time in, contact details (phone and/or email); or scanning the available QR code.
2. All persons entering the Club are to sanitise their hands as they enter the club – and frequently while they are in the club.
3. When entering the Club, patrons will be screened by staff for visible COVID-19 symptoms, or any other symptoms indicating that they are unwell.
4. Patrons displaying such symptoms will not be allowed into the Club, and will be advised to have a health check for COVID-19.
5. Should a patron be denied entry to the Club on health grounds, that person will not be permitted back into the Club until they provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test result.
6. Should a patron test positive for COVID-19, the relevant authorities will be informed and the Club's relevant entrance records will be provided to them.
7. Patrons must adhere to physical distancing throughout the Club – including the times when patrons might be queued for service.
8. Patrons are required to comply with the direction of the designated COVID-19-Safe Hygiene Marshall, who will be enforcing physical distancing, capacity limits, and any other COVID-19-Safe measures.
9. As much as possible, the Club requires cashless/contactless payment options.
10. Furniture and seating arrangements have been modified so patrons can comply with physical distancing requirements. Please refrain from moving or rearranging Club furniture.
11. Consumption of food and beverages within the Clubhouse must be done while seated.
